- (A) UUCB Phase We use California state-wide tiers and metrics here; as we move between UUCB Phases, we compare state restrictions with Contra Costa County Health Orders and keep our activities well within the more restrictive requirements.
- (B) State Level The State will move our county to the next tier once the following three criteria have been met for two consecutive weeks:
  - Cases Rate: Less than 7 new cases per 100,000 residents
  - Positivity Rate: Less than 8% of tests countywide are positive
  - Equity Metric: Less than 8% of tests for residents of the lowest quartile of the Healthy Places Index census tracts are positive
- (C) CA Indoor capacity allowances are established by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH); they are provided for reference, and may differ from the directives of Contra Costa Health Services (CCHS).
- (D) Indicators are the measurements/calculations that put UUCB into a specific Phase. State metrics can be found in the Blueprint for a Safer Economy on the CDPH website (cdph.ca.gov).
- (E) Examples of activities allowed at each Phase.
- (F) Safety Precautions provide a few of the pertinent details about safety measures at each Phase. (Protocols provide the full plan.) Key: Mask = facemasks required; <-6-> = physical distancing (6 feet) required; EB = building open for essential business only; AB = building open for authorized business and scheduled activities only; <-?-> = "safety zones" will be maintained during worship services for congregants/visitors who choose to continue wearing masks and prefer to remain physically distanced from others; Food = all eating indoors is prohibited; SSFood = self-service food is prohibited.
