**Policies of UU churches regarding vaccination status, from their websites**

(note that the first two churches are those offered as examples in the UUA web article on vaccination)

UU Nashua (NH)	<b>vaccination proof required</b> for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•staff</li> <li>•anyone working with children/youth</li> <li>•anyone leading worship or running tech from sanctuary</li> <li>•anyone singing in the building</li> <li>•anyone making in person pastoral care visits</li> <li>•anyone engaging with vulnerable populations in church role</li> </ul>	worship currently online; multiplatform may return when COVIDActNow status is Green (low risk)
UU East Brunswick (NJ)	<b>vaccination required</b> for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•staff</li> <li>•volunteers working directly with children and youth</li> </ul>	worship currently online only
UU SF	<b>proof of full vaccination required</b> for all age 12 and over, to be on premises	worship online and in person in sanctuary, vaccination required (no children under 12); some areas designated for RE activities (only children/youth, parents, RE staff/volunteers allowed in those areas)
Mt Diablo UUC (Walnut Creek)	<b>no vaccination requirements</b>	Worship Four Ways: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•in sanctuary, registration, limited seating, ages 12 and up only (distanced but not 6', not safe for younger children)</li> <li>•livestream on patio, location for Time for All Ages, families/children encouraged</li> <li>•livestream in social hall, registration, 6' distance</li> <li>•online</li> </ul>
UU Marin	<b>no vaccination requirements</b> publicized	all (including children) gather in Fellowship Hall (aka sanctuary), with patio for overflow; worship also online

UUC Santa Rosa	<b>vaccination required</b> for all age 12 and over, to enter indoor spaces; <b>OR</b> <b>negative COVID test</b> within 72 hours (proof of either must be shown on request)	worship online and in person in sanctuary
UU Oakland	<b>pending Board approval: vaccination or negative COVID test</b> (to be considered at Board meeting 10/26/21)	worship currently online; may return to in person worship mid November
UU Petaluma	<b>vaccination proof required</b> for staff who work with unvaccinated youth/children <b>vaccination strongly encouraged</b> for those eligible	worship currently online only
Berkeley Fellowship	<b>no vaccination requirements</b> publicized	worship currently online only
UU Live Oak (Alameda)	<b>prefer vaccinated</b> (apparently no proof required); those not vaccinated asked to attend online	worship in person indoors
San Jose UU	<b>no vaccination requirements</b> publicized	worship appears to be online only
UUC Palo Alto	<b>no vaccination requirements</b> publicized, though those who attend small group meetings in person are <b>expected</b> to be vaccinated	worship is online; in person worship is outdoors only
UU Petaluma	<b>no vaccination requirements</b> publicized	worship currently online only
UU San Mateo	agreement, waiver & <b>vaccination confirmation</b> via online form	worship in person outdoors twice monthly through October
UU Davis	protocols include <b>expectation</b> that those eligible will get vaccinated (apparently no proof required)	occasional in person worship appears to be outdoors
