**PARADE ROUTE AND TIMING**

The parade travels westbound (downhill) on Solano Avenue from Berkeley to Albany. The route is seven-eighths of a mile. The parade commences at 10am. But UUCB is positioned at the END, so please find us in the staging area by 10am to be ready to start when our turn comes. (See map on reverse.)

**CLOTHING – Wear GREEN!!!**

Green is this year’s Solano Stroll color theme. Also, wear your yellow “Love” t-shirt (available at the book table in the Social Hall) or other bright color! But most important, dress for comfort and the outdoors! Comfy shoes, hat, sunglasses and sunscreen.

**PLAN**

Don’t underestimate how much time you will need to travel, park, and find your destination.

**PETS**

Only animals trained to assist persons with disabilities are permitted at the Solano Stroll.

**HOW TO GET TO THE STROLL**

***Carpools***

Carpools are encouraged for those who wish to drive. Street parking is available, but may not be near your destination. Expect parking regulations to be strictly enforced.

***Shuttles***

**Free shuttles run 10am-7pm from the North Berkeley BART station to Marin Avenue** which runs parallel, one block south of Solano Avenue. The shuttle runs up and down Marin and stops at the intersections with traffic signals until Masonic/the BART tracks.\*\* Wait times average 20 to 30 minutes. Shuttles are wheelchair accessible and are provided courtesy of our event sponsors. Please thank them.  
\*\*Berkeley stops: The Alameda, Colusa.  
Albany stops (along Marin): Peralta, Santa Fe, Masonic.

***Bike***

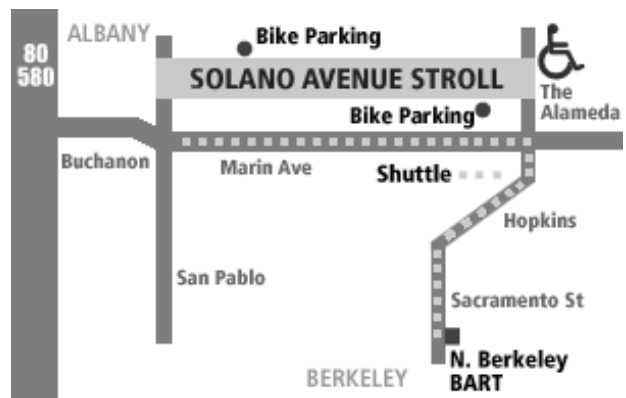
Ride your bike and enjoy free valet parking at two locations on Solano Avenue, Wells Fargo Bank (1800 Solano) on the east [Berkeley] end, and by Albany Arts Gallery (1245 Solano) on west [Albany] end. Thank you to the Albany Strollers & Rollers for continuing to provide this wonderful accommodation.

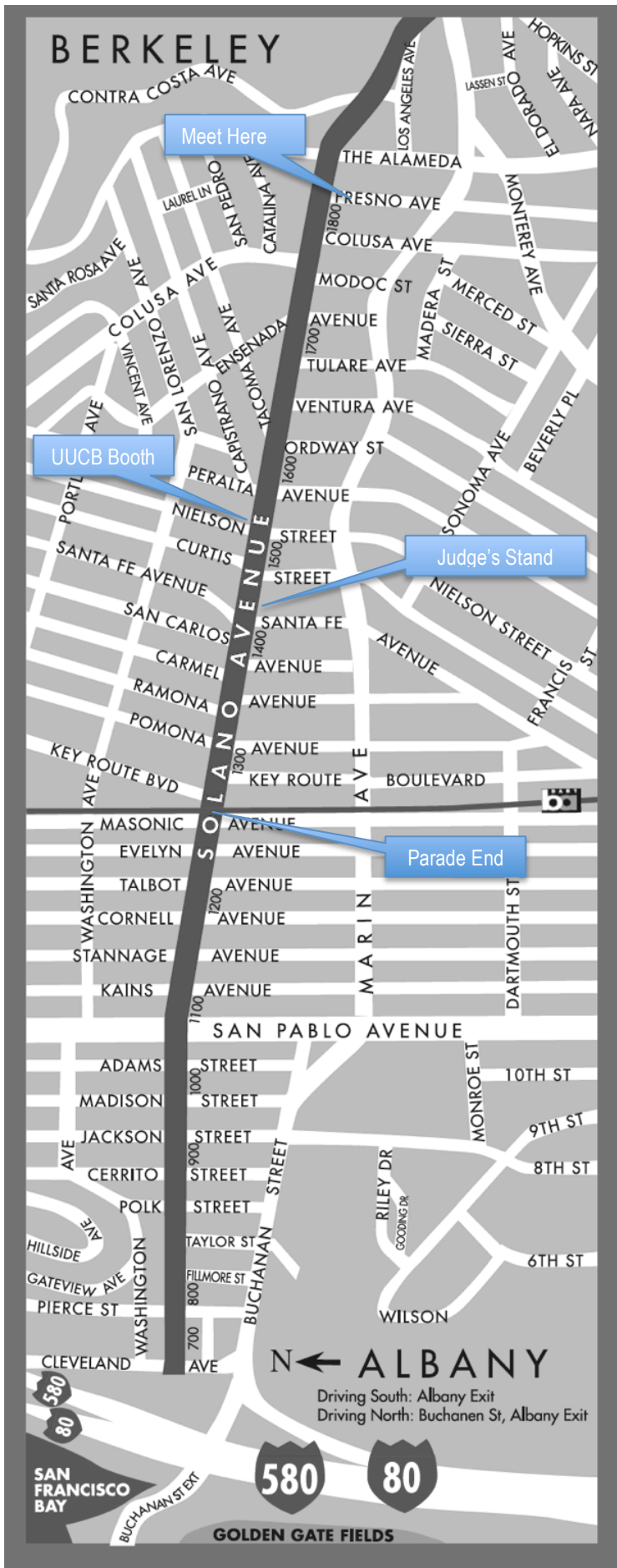
***AC Transit and BART***

You can also use AC transit bus numbers #7, #18, #25, #72R, #72 and #72M. To take BART, you can take the shuttle from the North Berkeley BART station, or walk about 15 minutes from the El Cerrito BART station. To get to the corner of Solano and Alameda, you can also take the #25 bus from the El Cerrito BART station or the #7, #18, or #25 buses from the downtown Berkeley BART station. To get to the corner of Solano and San Pablo, take the #72, #72R or #72M from the El Cerrito BART station. ***Accessible Parking***
